This SFR equipment has a heavy-duty Dressta steel drum along with a winch line attachment with brackets attached to the drum. There is a tensioning apparatus that prevents the line from coming into contact with the slope face. A cleaning system and precision guide are part of the machine. Fire Tractor Dozers The Dressta fire tractor dozers are an excellent defense in forest fire work in terms of prevention, containment and cleaning up forest fires. These fire dozers are commonly employed in difficult work environments such as working with falling trees, dirt, airborne sand and heavy ash. Firefighting crews use these machines for removing combustible debris, clearing fire lines and making paths. Additional fire suppression mechanisms include nozzles, an onboard control unit and external sensors. A forestry cab kit helps to protect the operator and the machine with guards, steel mesh screens, sweeps and metallic fire curtains to eliminate damage from trees that fall during the fire. Special fire-resistant sheeting keeps the electrical components safe within the tractors and reinforced guards protect the hydraulic cylinders and the hoses. Fire plows, bush blades and winches are some of the other pieces of equipment used to combat fires.

Special features are implemented to prevent overheating such as cooling modules for the powertrain, charge air and radiator and the direct drive powertrain. Belt Shifting Conveyor belts are used by mining applications to transport debris and minerals from the seam where they are found to different locations for reprocessing. The SB-85 Dressta model is commonly used for rapidly repositioning and realigning conveyor belts on the job site. This unit can be utilized to move railway tracks or employed in confined locations.
